HOW TO TRANSFER INTO BERKSHIRE COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S PTA PROGRAM

1. To transfer into the PTA program at BCC the following requirements must be met. (CCV courses meeting these requirements are listed below, but other transfer options may be available):

- _____ ENG-0041, Basic Writing I (if applicable)
- _____ ENG-0042, Basic Writing II (if applicable)
- _____ EDU-0030, Basic Reading (if applicable)
- _____ ENG-0020, Foundations of Reading and Writing (if applicable)
- _____ MAT-1060, Problem Solving with Mathematics (if applicable)
- _____ High school college prep or college level Biology or Anatomy & Physiology (in the last 5 years with a "C" or better)
- _____ Graduate from high school within the last two years with an average of "B" (80%) or rank in the upper third of the graduating class

OR

- Complete a minimum of 10 credits of college level PTA support courses (any non-PTA designated courses) with a "C" or better
- _____ Completion of 20 hours of documented clinical observation in a Physical Therapy setting

2. Once all requirements listed above have been met, the student must complete the college and program admissions process through the BCC Admissions office. The application process includes all components listed below:

- _____ Submission of college application and fees
- _____ Submission of official college transcripts from CCV and any other relevant institutions
- _____ Submission of high school transcript or GED
- _____ Submission of PTA matriculation and observation forms

All the courses listed below are required for BCC graduation from the PTA program. Up to 29 credits can be taken at CCV for transfer to BCC. Required BCC courses and the CCV equivalents are listed below:
