

## **Northwestern Connecticut Community College students:**

### **HOW TO TRANSFER INTO BERKSHIRE COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S PTA PROGRAM**

1. To transfer into the PTA program at BCC the following requirements must be met. (NCCC courses meeting these requirements are listed below, but other transfer options may be available):

- \_\_\_\_\_ ENG 010A & B, Reading (if applicable)
- \_\_\_\_\_ ENG 011, Writing (if applicable)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Math 099 (if applicable)
- \_\_\_\_\_ High school Biology or Anatomy & Physiology or Bio. 100 or higher (in the last 5 years with a "C" or better)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Graduate from high school within the last two years with an average of "B" (80%) or rank in the upper third of the graduating class

OR

- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete a minimum of 10 credits of college level PTA support courses (any non-PTA designated courses) with a "C" or better
- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of 20 hours of documented clinical observation in a Physical Therapy setting

2. Once all requirements listed above have been met, the student must complete the college and program admissions process through the BCC Admissions office. The application process includes all components listed below:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Submission of college application and fees
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submission of official college transcripts from NCCC and any other relevant institutions
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submission of high school transcript or GED
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submission of PTA matriculation and observation forms

All the courses listed below are required for BCC graduation from the PTA program. Up to 26 credits can be taken at NCCC for transfer to BCC. Required BCC courses and the NCCC equivalents are listed below:
